APPEAL NO. ICSSR/R/E/23/00033 BEFORE  
FIRST APPELLATE AUTHORITY UNDER  
RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI ACT), 2005

**Background:**

The Appellant, Shri Jai Prakash Meena, email address - [jpramgarh@gmail.com](mailto:jpramgarh@gmail.com) has preferred the present appeal dated July 13, 2023, under section 19(1) of RTI Act and received by the office of First Appellate Authority (FAA) on July 21, 2023, against the application number ICSSR/R/E/00033 dated June 6, 2023, requesting, the intervention of FAA in providing information sought by him in the RTI application.

**Observations:**

I have gone through the contents of his appeal dated July 13, 2023, as also the application. number ICSSR/R/E/00033 dated June 6, 2023 in the matter. It is observed that vide his RTI application dated June 6, 2023, the appellant has sought information on


- (1) The schedule of upcoming ICSSR-sponsored Capacity Building Programs. Provide a list along with the venue.
- (2) The schedule of upcoming ICSSR-sponsored seminars, conferences, workshops, etc. Provide a list along with the venue.

The Appellant has made his appeal on the grounds that CPIO has not provided any kind of reply on the sought information.

I observe that CPIO has provided the similar information dated May 26, 2023, on the email address - [jpramgarh@gmail.com](mailto:jpramgarh@gmail.com) available on record. Therefore, seeking same information, again does not seems to be good habit, it leads to misuse of the RTI act. However. CPIO is directed to furnish the information within five working days. The RTI mechanism is meant for providing available information which is not exempted under the provisions of the RTI Act.

**Order:**

The appeal is accordingly disposed of. Copy of this order be sent to the appellant and CPIO.
