GUIDELINES FOR EVALUATION OF TYPING TEST (Hindi/English)

NATURE OF MISTAKES

Typing errors made during the test will be categorized and penalized as either **Full Mistakes** or **Half Mistakes** as detailed below:

A. FULL MISTAKES

The following errors will be treated as Full Mistakes:

1. Substitution of Words/Figures:

Substituting a correct word or figure with an incorrect one (except for transposition of words).

2. Addition of Extra Words/Figures:

Adding a word or figure that is not found in the original passage.

3. Spelling Errors:

Any error in spelling due to repetition, addition, omission, or substitution of letter(s). *Examples:*

• "spelling" typed as: seeplings, sepling, speling, seepling, etc.

4. Repetition of Words/Figures:

Repeating a word or figure unnecessarily. *Example:*

• "I shall shall be grateful..."

5. Incomplete Words:

Any word that is half-typed or incomplete will be treated as a full mistake.

B. HALF MISTAKES

The following errors will be treated as Half Mistakes:

1. Wrong Capitalisation:

Using a capital letter in place of a small letter and vice versa. *(Note: This does not apply to Hindi typewriting scripts.)*

2. Punctuation Errors:

Omitting, adding, or substituting punctuation marks.

RESULT CALCULATION

The performance in the typing test will be evaluated on the basis of **Gross Speed** and **Net Speed**.

1. Gross Speed (Words Per Minute - WPM):

Gross Speed = (Total number of words typed, including correct and incorrect) ÷ 10

2. Net Speed (WPM):

Net Speed = (Total number of words typed - Total Mistakes) \div 10

• Mistake Calculation:

- Each Full Mistake = 1 mistake
- Each **Half Mistake** = 0.5 mistake
