

Earlier INSSPEL database covered only Economics and Political Science periodicals, but the current one will be exhaustive. It includes the Indian journals which are under UGC-CARE List, journals subscribed by NASSDOC, and ICSSR suggested journals. The service will largely benefit the researchers who are pursuing social science research in India or in India. At present, anyone can access this database upon his/her registration.
