Background

For social science to realise their potential in shaping public policy, it is imperative that the research ecosystem is dynamic and vibrant; the institutions governing it are robust and effective; and those who produce quality research are strong and well governed. It is important to develop social sciences along with natural sciences by setting up institutes of excellence for the twin inter-wined purposes of nurturing social scientists who could then work on developing theoretical formulations pertaining to specific Indian context and to meet and fulfil that end promoting and encouraging research endeavours. Thus, enhancing competencies and skill among social scientists to make them to stay relevant within a rapid changing environment becomes essential. Against this backdrop, Centre for Social Studies, Surat is organising a **Two Week 'Capacity Building Programme' (CBP) for young Social Science Faculty during 19th April to 01st May 2021. Due to pandemic situation this course will be held ONLINE.**

Objectives

The broad objective of the proposed capacity building programme is to provide training in social science research methodology to the teachers of social science disciplines like Economics, Sociology, Political Science, Social work, Management, Geography, and History etc. More specifically the Course aims to address the following aspects.

- Develop understanding on philosophy of research.
- Enhance skills to prepare an appropriate research proposal, including conducting an overview of literature, formulating research questions and hypotheses, collection of information and analysis.
- Help them to understand the application of appropriate Statistical techniques in various types of researches keeping in mind nature of the data.
- Enhance the capability for planning and writing a research paper/book for publication.
- To acquaint the participants with the latest developments and trends in the field of Social Science research.

The course is expected to benefit participants from all social sciences. By the end of the programme they are expected to develop conceptual clarity and practical knowledge to undertake quality research and writing good research papers, field reports and project proposals etc.
